**OLD BUSINESS**

**Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance – Authorize Solicitor to advertise for Public Hearing**

Pete Lamana moved to authorize Solicitor Jim McNamara to advertise the Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance. Second by Jim Brownlow. Vote was unanimous.

**Appointments to the Planning Commission** – Jim Brownlow stated the Board had an excellent response to the request for volunteers to serve on the Planning Commission. There were five excellent candidates to fill two openings. The decision was difficult since there were more than two qualified to fill the positions.

Jim Brownlow moved to appoint Bobb Carson to fill the term to expire 12/31/2008, and Stefani Campbell to fill the term which will expire 12/31/2006. Second by Chuck Halderman. Vote was unanimous.

**Township Insurance Package 2005/2/1/2006-** Pete Lamana moved to award the Municipal Insurance, Auto and Workers Compensation Insurance for 2005/2006 with a renewal date of February 1, 2006 to MRM Trust. Seconded by Rob Zisko. Vote was unanimous.

Dennis Steskal discussed the Springtown Water System and the location of the proposed water tank.

Chuck Halderman asked the Board to use common sense when making a decision concerning the Water System in Springtown.

Bob Bell discussed the December Police Report.

Hans thanked the Board for continuing with the Wellhead Protection Plan, which Hans secured as a member of the Township Authority.
