CRIMES ALLEGED: Burglary-2 counts, Criminal Trespass-2 counts, Criminal Conspiracy-1 count, Theft By Unlawful Taking or Disposition-1 count, Theft From Motor Vehicle-17 counts, Receiving Stolen Property-19 counts, Criminal Attempt-Theft-3 counts.

ACCUSED: Two Springfield area juveniles

Location: Winding Rd., Roundhouse Rd., Oak Lane, Pleasant View Rd., Township Rd. - Springfield Township, Bucks County

Press Release Summary:

Springfield Twp. Police have filed juvenile allegations for the above charges against two Springfield area juveniles as a result of police investigation of numerous acts of Theft and Burglary that occurred between May 20 and May 22, 2011. The petitioned juveniles stole various items, including a small motorcycle, from unlocked vehicles and garages of residents, primarily during the daylight hours. Springfield Twp. Police were assisted by the Pa. State Police, Dublin.

The majority of the stolen property has been recovered and returned. Township Police are still attempting to reunite a GPS to its' owner. Anyone missing a GPS is asked to contact Springfield Twp. P.D.

The frequency of thefts from vehicles has risen sharply everywhere. It is strongly encouraged that people lock their houses and vehicles at all times, and also to discourage forcible entry to vehicles by keeping valuables stored in vehicles to a minimum.
