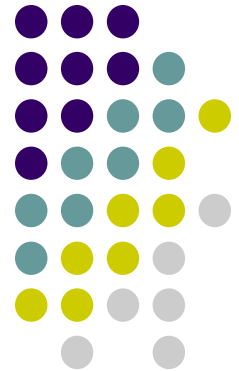

Southeastern PA VOA is part of a national collaboration of organizations and citizens trained to meet community needs in the wake of a large-scale disaster. VOA coordinates planning efforts and, during a disaster, matches community needs with services provided by member VOA agencies. This cooperative effort has proven to be the most effective way for a wide variety of volunteers and organizations to work together in a crisis. Volunteers are trained to work before, during and after a large-scale disaster.

Citizens Corps, a key SEPA VOA member, provides citizens the opportunity to participate in a range of measures to make their families, homes and communities safer from the threats of crime, terrorism and disasters of all kinds.

VOA/Citizen Corps offers members of your organization free disaster trainings. Get peace of mind knowing your members are prepared before a disaster strikes and can look after themselves and their families post-disaster.

Trainers can do on-site training for groups of 15+ at their location of choice. Or, if preferred, local members can be trained as VOA/Citizen Corps trainers so new members can be trained locally as they come aboard.
