## 1. Proposed Definitions:

An Event Venue is a <u>privately-owned</u> building or property used or leased to host multiple <u>scheduled events</u>, including (but not limited to): reunions, weddings, concerts, banquets, parties, shows, conferences, meetings, retreats, fund-raisers, exhibits, fairs, etc. A <u>Principal Use Event Venue</u> is a commercial business whose primary product is event presentations. In contrast, an <u>Accessory Use Event Venue</u> is a site whose primary function is some other use, but which <u>sometimes</u> hosts events, commonly to provide funding for its principal operation. Event attendees may be solicited by direct invitation, advertisement, or public announcement.
